CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

Camp should be a fun place for EVERYONE. These guidelines are meant to keep each Camper safe while insuring respect to them and their property. Please review the following code of conduct with your child and ask him/her to sign it.

1. Stay safe while having fun.
2. Always follow the directions of AGBU Pasadena Summer Day Camp staff and follow the AGBU Pasadena Summer Day Camp rules.
3. Respect your environment by not littering. Treat Camp equipment and property with care. Respect other people's property.
4. Vandalizing or drawing on the Camp buildings or property is not permitted.
5. Do not use foul language.
6. Accept and get along with others. Malicious teasing, practical jokes and bullying of any kind will not be tolerated.
7. Do not bring or use any form of tobacco product, controlled substance, illegal substance or alcohol.
8. I understand that these rules and guidelines are for my safety and the protection of campers and staff.
9. I understand that if I choose to violate this code while at AGBU Pasadena Summer Day Camp, the AGBU Pasadena Summer Day Camp Director and staff will take appropriate steps to stop my actions or behavior. These steps may include: a verbal warning; sitting out of an activity; parent notification; or dismissal from Camp without refund.

AGBU SUMMER DAY CAMP PASADENA STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, AGBU and AGBU BOARD MEMBERS AND EMPLOYEES (collectively referred to as the, "*Released Parties*" hereinafter) enter into this agreement with the undersigned Camper and/or Parent/Guardian (if Camper is a minor):

-COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND WAIVER OF CLAIM AGREEMENT-**

Permission to Participate, Waiver of Negligence, Medical Release & Complete Release of Liability for Participation and Transportation for AGBU SUMMER DAY CAMP PASADENA (hereinafter, "Camp Activity"), organized by the AGBU Western District Committee, taking place from June 5 – July 28, 2017.

1. Voluntary Participation. (hereinafter "Camper" is voluntarily participating in the Camp Activity with *Released Parties* from

June 5 – June 9, 2017

Camper and/or Parent Guardian understands that *Released Parties'* employees and volunteers will be transporting campers in private or public vehicles, by licensed drivers, for field trips and other outings.

Camp Activity includes and is not limited to the following: cooking, sports, theater, dance, music, arts and crafts, language and culture, computer, field trips, obstacle courses, hiking, volleyball, and basketball. **Note:** If the Camper does not want to attend a specific field trip, he or she may not attend Camp that day.

2. Assumption of Risk. Camper and/or Parent/Guardian acknowledges that Camper and/or Parent/Guardian fully understands that participation in the **Camp Activity** may involve risk of serious injury or death, and/or economic losses which may result not only from the Camper's actions, inactions, or negligence, but also from the action, inaction, or negligence of others, transportation, the condition of facilities, equipment or areas where the event will take place, the rules of play, and/or the type of event of activity. In consideration for being permitted to participate in the **Camp Activity**, Camper and/or Parent/Guardian, on behalf of all their heirs, successors and assigns agree to indemnify and hold *Released Parties* harmless from any and all claims arising from Camper's participation in the **Camp Activity**; Camper and/or Parent/Guardian assumes all risks of personal injuries to Camper, including medical or hospital bills, permanent or partial disability, death and/or damage to property, caused by and/or arising from Camper's participation in this **Camp Activity**.

3. Release of Liability. In consideration for the above named camper participating in the **Camp Activity**, the undersigned agrees to indemnify and hold free and harmless all persons involved in conductive the **Camp Activity** and the *Released Parties* from and against all claims, demands and actions arising out of such participation. To the fullest extent allowed by law, the undersigned agrees to pay without right of subrogation, all uninsured medical expenses incurred by the Camper as a result of his/her participation in **Camp Activity** even if the expenses result from the alleged **negligence** of **Released Parties**.

4. Limitations on Liability. Released Parties liability for damages arising out this agreement and any services performed hereunder, whether in an action based on contract, tort or otherwise, shall not exceed the total amount paid by Camper to Released Parties hereunder for services performed.

5. Knowing and Voluntary Execution. The undersigned has carefully read this Waiver and Release and fully understands its contents. The undersigned certifies that the undersigned is at least 18 years of age. The undersigned is aware that this is a **RELEASE OF LIABILITY**, and **COVENANT NOT TO SUE**, with serious legal consequences, and a binding contract between the undersigned and the persons and Released Parties mentioned above, and the undersigned so agrees of his/her own free will.

6. Governing Law and Arbitration. **Any claim or dispute arising from the Camper's participation in the program or this agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California, and shall be adjudicated by binding arbitration before the JAMS in Los Angeles, CA which shall have the same powers as would a State court.**

ADDITIONAL TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING

Registration: Registration(s) will be processed in the order received. A NONREFUNDABLE DEPOSIT OF \$100 IS REQUIRED WHEN SUBMITTING THIS REGISTRATION FORM. The deposit is applicable to the total cost of the week.

Rates: **\$190/week** for Camp Activity from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm. Includes lunch and snacks. Rate of Camp is per week, not per day. **Per day rates are \$40***. If camper is planning on attending field trip for the week, camper must attend at least two days of camp before the field trip day.

Credits: There are no credits for missed days.

Drop-off & Pick-up: You must always park; walk your child to and from the entrance to the counselors; and Sign In/Out each child.

Personal Items: No personal items are allowed at camp, examples: toys, electronics, cellphones, etc. The Released Parties are not liable for lost or stolen items.

Clothing: Campers must wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes; no sandals or flip-flops permitted (Except on Water Play Day).

Medication: Do not send medication with the Camper. This includes cough drops. Please keep your child home if he/she is ill.

Cancellation: Refunds will only be given for medical reasons. Please contact the day camp Director for more information. In the unlikely event that AGBU cancels the Summer Day Camp Program, responsibility and liability is limited to return of all payments received for the AGBU Summer Day Camp - Pasadena.

Extended hours: Extended hours allow Parents to drop off campers before camp starts. Extended hours are available from 8:00 am – 9:00am, 4:30 pm- 5:30pm for a fee of \$10/hour per child. Children are not permitted to be dropped off, unsupervised, prior to the start of camp. Please register for extended care if desired.

Media Release: Photographs, videos, etc. are taken of the campers to record the amazing memories we create at AGBU Summer Day Camp – Pasadena. These photos, videos, etc. may be used on current and future marketing materials, social media posts, and other outlets for fundraising and/or promotional purposes. By signing below, you acknowledge and irrevocably authorize *AGBU and Released Parties* to use photographs, videos, etc. in any and all forms.
