CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

Camp should be a fun place for EVERYONE. These guidelines are meant to keep each Camper safe while ensuring respect to them and their property. Please review the following code of conduct with your child and ask him/her to sign it.

1. I will stay safe while having fun.
2. I will always follow the directions of Camp staff and follow the AGBU Camp Amaras rules.
3. I will respect my environment by not littering.
4. I will treat Camp equipment and property with care.
5. I will respect other people's property.
6. I understand that vandalizing or drawing on the Camp buildings or property is not permitted.
7. I will not use foul language.
8. I will accept and get along with others. I understand that malicious teasing, practical jokes and bullying of any kind will not be tolerated.
9. I will not bring or use any form of tobacco products, controlled substances, illegal substances or alcohol.
10. I will not bring any toys to camp.
11. I will not use my phone or any other personal technology devices during camp hours.
12. I understand that these rules and guidelines are for my safety and the protection of campers and staff.
13. I understand that if I choose to violate this code while at AGBU Camp Amaras, the Camp Director and staff will take appropriate steps to stop my actions or behavior. These steps may include: a verbal warning; sitting out of an activity; parent notification; or dismissal from Camp without refund.

AGBU CAMP AMARAS STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, AGBU, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES AND INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS hereinafter collectively referred to as, the “*Released Parties*” enter into this agreement with the undersigned Camper and Parent/Guardian (if Camper is a minor):

**-VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION-
-ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, COVENANT NOT TO SUE & INDEMNITY-**

Permission to Participate, Waiver of Negligence, Medical Release & Complete Release of Liability for Participation and Transportation for AGBU CAMP AMARAS (hereinafter, “*Camp Activity*”), organized by the AGBU Western District Committee, taking place from June 11 – August 3, 2018.

1. I, _____ (hereinafter “*Camper*”), understand that I am voluntarily participating in AGBU Camp Amaras. Camper and Parent Guardian understand that *Released Parties*’ employees and volunteers will be transporting campers in private or public vehicles, by licensed drivers, for field trips and other outings.

Camp Activity includes and is not limited to the following: cooking, sports, theater, dance, music, arts and crafts, language and culture, computer, field trips, obstacle courses, hiking, volleyball, and basketball. **Note:** If the Camper does not want to attend a specific field trip, he or she may not attend Camp that day.

2. Assumption of Risk. Camper and Parent/Guardian acknowledge that Camper and Parent/Guardian fully understand that participation in the **Camp Activity** may involve risk of serious injury or death, and/or economic losses which may result not only from the Camper’s actions, inactions, or negligence, but also from the action, inaction, or negligence of others, transportation, the condition of facilities, equipment or areas where the event will take place, the rules of play, and/or the type of event or activity. Camper and Parent/Guardian assume and accept all risks and dangers of participating in the **Camp Activity**, whether or not described above, and including the possibility of the negligence of the *Released Parties*. Parent Guardian hereby gives Camper permission to participate in the **Camp Activity**. Parent/Guardian has discussed the **Camp Activity** and the risks associated therewith with Camper, who assures Parent/Guardian that he/she understands them and wished to participate nevertheless.

3. Release of Liability and Indemnity. Parent/Guardian (on behalf of himself/herself, his/her spouse, relatives and heirs and, to the extent permitted under applicable laws, on behalf of Camper) hereby releases and agrees not to sue the *Released Parties*’ with respect to any and all claims of injury, disability, death, products liability (including strict liability), breach of contract or other loss or damage to person or property suffered by me or by Camper, arising in whole or in part from Parent/Guardian’s and/or Camper’s participation in **Camp Activity** or otherwise being on *Released Parties*’ property. In addition, Parent/Guardian (on behalf of himself/herself) agrees to indemnify and hold *Released Parties* harmless from any and all claims and damages brought by Parent/Guardian, or by or on behalf of Parent/Guardian or Camper, another camper, a member of my or the Camper’s family, or another person or entity, in each case, arising from, or out of, or in any way related to, a loss suffered by Parent/Guardian and/or Camper, or caused (in whole or in part) by Parent/Guardian and/or Camper. The foregoing agreements of release and indemnity include, but are not limited to, claims of negligence (expressly holding gross negligence and intentional misconduct) of the *Released Parties*.



4. Other. In the event of an emergency, Parent/Guardian (a) grant permission to the physician and/or treatment facility selected by AGBU Camp Amaras to administer treatment, including hospitalization, and (b) release, hold harmless and indemnify the *Released Parties* from and against (i) any and all losses, injuries and/or damages suffered by Parent/Guardian and/or Camper as a result of such treatment, and (ii) all costs associated with any such treatment.

5. Limitations on Liability. *Released Parties'* liability for damages arising out this agreement and any services performed hereunder, whether in an action based on contract, tort or otherwise, shall not exceed the total amount paid by Camper to Released Parties hereunder for services performed.

6. Knowing and Voluntary Execution. The undersigned has carefully read the foregoing and fully understands its contents. The undersigned certifies that the undersigned is at least 18 years of age. The undersigned is aware that this is a **RELEASE OF LIABILITY**, and **COVENANT NOT TO SUE**, with serious legal consequences, and a binding contract between the undersigned and the Released Parties, and the undersigned so agrees of his/her own free will.

7. Governing Law and Arbitration. Any claim or dispute arising from the Camper's participation in the program or this agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California, and shall be adjudicated by binding arbitration before the JAMS in Los Angeles, CA which shall have the same powers as would a State court.

ADDITIONAL TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING

Registration: Registration(s) will be processed in the order received. A NONREFUNDABLE DEPOSIT OF \$100 IS REQUIRED WHEN SUBMITTING THIS REGISTRATION FORM. The deposit is applicable to the total cost of the week.

Rates: **\$220/week** for Camp Activity from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm for first camper. **\$200/week** for Camp Activity from 9:00-4:00 pm for each sibling. Rates include lunch, snacks, and field trips. Rates of Camp are per week, not per day. The full per week rates will be charged regardless of number of days Camper(s) attend for that week.

Refunds/Credits: There are no refunds and/or credits for missed days of camp.

Drop-off & Pick-up: You must always park; walk your child to and from the entrance to the counselors; and Sign In/Out each child.

Personal Items: No personal items are allowed at camp, examples: toys, electronics, cellphones, etc. The *Released Parties* are not liable for lost or stolen items. Campers will not be allowed to use such items during camp hours. If personal items are used, they will be confiscated for the day.

Clothing: Campers must wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes; no sandals or flip-flops permitted (Except on Water Play Day).

Medication: Do not send medication with the Camper. This includes cough drops. Please keep your child home if he/she is ill.

Cancellation: Refunds will only be given for medical reasons. Please contact the day camp Director for more information. In the unlikely event that AGBU Camp Amaras is cancelled, responsibility and liability is limited to return of all payments received for AGBU Camp Amaras.

Extended hours: Extended hours allow Parents to drop off campers before camp starts and pick up campers after camp ends. Extended hours are available from 8:00 am – 9:00am, 4:00 pm- 5:00pm for a fee of \$10/hour per child. Children are not permitted to be dropped off, unsupervised, prior to the start of camp. Please register for extended care if desired. You must notify the camp Director of desired extended hours one week prior to the start of that camp week.

Media Release: Photographs, videos, quotations and likeness are taken of the campers to record the amazing memories we create at AGBU Camp Amaras. These photos, videos, etc. may be used on current and future marketing materials, social media posts, and other outlets for fundraising and/or promotional purposes. By signing below, you acknowledge and irrevocably authorize the *Released Parties* to use photographs, videos, quotations and likeness in any and all forms, and agree that neither I nor Camper shall be entitled to a compensation for such use.
